CPM Sri Lanka Opens Global Pathways for SMEs Through Digital Innovation PayPal Pathway to SME and Business Growth 4th June 2026

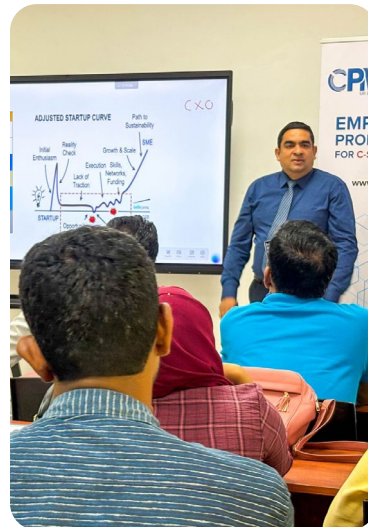

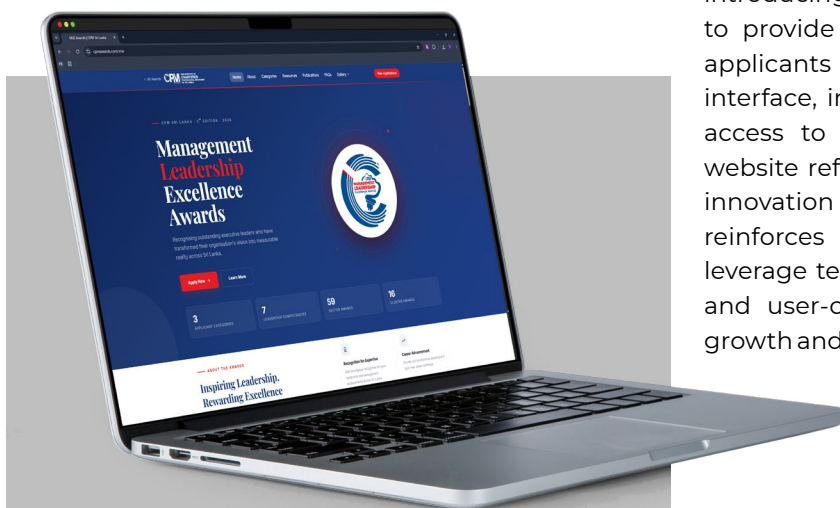

Transforming Strategic Thinking Through the Power of Big Data and AI

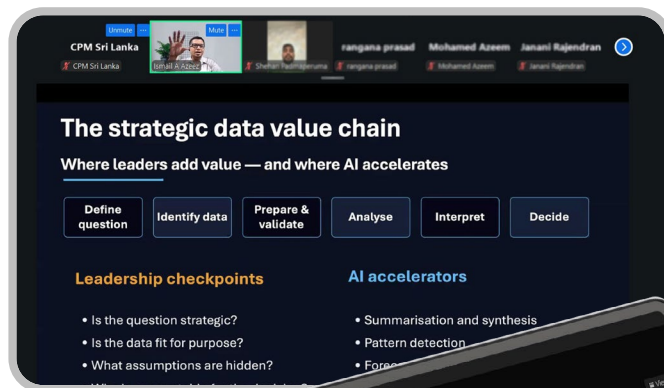
